All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates, except when being judged or in designated warm-up areas. No retractable leashes or prong collars permitted in the building. No ex-pens permitted in the building.

No overnight parking or camping permitted at the show site.

ADOG's building is a 5,800 square-foot facility, air conditioned and fully matted. Crating space is limited, so we request that you bring stackable crates if you have multiple dogs. To protect the mats, please place pads or towels under your crates.

The "show grounds" for these trials consists of the show building and the parking lot.

The building will be available to exhibitors at 9:00 AM on Friday, August 11, 2017.

Crates and chairs may remain in the building each night. Dogs must be removed from the building within 30 minutes after judging ends each day.

The parking area has limited space behind the building for RVs; no hook-ups are available.

On Friday, August 11, do not park in front of the other businesses; sufficient parking is available behind ADOG's building.

Smoking is not permitted in the building.

The judge will not wait for dogs holding up a ring.

At both the show site and the motels, please pick up after yourselves and your dogs.

Dumpsters in and around the parking lot cannot be used for any trash.

A dog that bites a person on the Show Grounds may be reported by the Show Committee to DeKalb County Animal Control.

Trial Entry Information and Trial Regulations

Entries are acknowledged by email as soon as they are received and processed. **Please review and respond right away if any changes are noted.** Armband numbers are confirmed and judging programs are distributed by email for all entries. This will be shortly after closing, when final judging assignments are complete, and exhibitor armband numbers have been assigned. Premium lists for future trials will also be sent out by email.

Refunds will be given in accordance with AKC regulations and for entries withdrawn in writing or by email before the closing date and time. The club will give refunds, less \$7 per entry, for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial; submit a letter of explanation from your veterinarian on his/her office stationery along with your request before the start of the trial.

No refunds for errors on entry forms or if a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused. No refunds if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Changes or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email before the close of entries. Indicate '**UDX**' if you are entering both OB & UB and you want no entry if one class or the other is already closed due to entry limitations (Obedience Regulations: Chapter 1 Section 27).

Obedience High Jump Height and **Pre-Open / Pre-Utility Jump Height** is required for all entries in the classes with jumps.

Entry Fees must be paid by credit card when entering online. If a check is returned, we will add any bank fees to the amount due.

Transfers (formerly called move-ups) will be accepted in accordance with AKC regulations if you have earned a new title, and if the class is not full. The fee difference will apply for transfers from a non-regular to a regular or optional titling class. Completed and signed transfer form must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than **30 minutes** before the start of judging for the trial.

Show Site Show hours are 7:00 am–10:00 pm Saturday & Sunday. No dogs may be left in the building overnight.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.

3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience & Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).
